



AMC strives to provide high quality care for our patients, visitors, employees, and community. In response to the governor's movement into Phase-3, we have updated our restricted visitor policy effective Monday, March 8, 2021.

Our visitation policy, while following CDC guidelines related to COVID are:

- **NON-COVID Patients:** Visitors may or may not be able to wait in waiting areas due to social distancing limitations and should leave phone # to be contacted if waiting in car.
 - **ED-** 1 unique visitor for duration of stay.
 - **Inpatients-** 1 unique visitor for duration of stay.
 - **Labor & Delivery-** 2 unique visitors for duration of stay. **Observation** (pregnant) patients will be allowed only 1 unique visitor for duration of stay.
 - **Pediatric Patients-** 2 unique visitors for duration of stay.
 - **ICU-** 1 unique visitor for duration of stay during ICU visitation hours.
 - **Surgery** -1 unique visitor per patient pre/post-surgery.
 - **Patients with cognitive, physical or mobility impairments-** 2 unique visitors for duration of stay with only 1 allowed at a time.
 - **Physician's Offices-** Please contact your physician/provider for specific instructions on visitors.
- **COVID-19 + Patients-** Only in end of life circumstances.

* **Unique visitor** means the visitor cannot be changed/ rotated/ substituted for duration of patient's stay & **MUST BE ASYMPTOMATIC***

Children are NOT allowed for visitation

Clergy IS ALLOWED per patient/family request

****All visitors will be screened daily. Visitors must be asymptomatic and wear a mask at all times. There will be subjective symptom screening daily in room, or at screening station upon re-entry. To conserve supplies, **visitors are to bring a mask from home.****

The Entrances listed below have staffed screeners available to screen all visitors, patients, and employees:

- **ER entrance is open 24 hours a day**
- **Main lobby is open between 6 AM - 5 PM**

We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause our patients/ visitors/ employees, but your safety is our # 1 priority!
